

2022 PCCGA PACE OF PLAY POLICY

TEE PLACEMENTS

Have been set up to match the yardage on the scorecard.

HOLE No. 7

Mandatory wave up policy in effect!

Please wave up the group on the tee when your group has reached the green.

SLOW PLAY POLICY

The pace of play for PCCGA events has been set at 4 hours and 20 minutes.

The beginning of the round is defined as when the first player puts the tee in the ground.

The officer in charge at the first tee will note the beginning of the round (time wise) on the group's scorecard.

Upon reaching the 18th green, the scorecard must immediately be turned in to the pro shop staff.

The pro shop staff will note the time of the last putt made on the 18th green on the pace of play chart for the event.

Any slow play penalties incurred will be group penalties and will affect any and all prizes.

Slow play penalty breakdown is as follows:

- a) 4:20 pace or less = no penalty and congratulations.
- b) 4:21 to 4:30 pace = 1 shot penalty incurred.
- c) 4:31 to 4:40 pace = 2 shot penalty incurred (and the scale continues).

Any group(s) behind a penalized group(s) will not incur a penalty(s) so long as their pace matches that of the adjusted target pace of play!
