2022 PENNSAUKEN COUNTRY CLUB GOLF ASSOCIATION EVENT "FORMATS"

OPENING 2–3–4 MIXER TOURNAMENT: Four player format counting all 4 low net scores on par 3's, 3 low net scores on par 4's and 2 low net scores on par 5's. Players receive full handicap.

THREE IN ONE (BLIND DRAW): Partner event with three (3) different six (6) hole formats. Holes 1 thru 6 are partner gross aggregate, Holes 7 thru 12 are two player scramble (3 tee shots each) and Holes 13 thru 18 are select drive – alternate shot format (3 tee shots each) with gross and net division winners. Team receives 50% of handicap total for net division scoring.

HARRY ESTEP MEMORIAL: Better ball of partners over 18 holes with full handicap as it falls on the scorecard with gross and net division winners.

MEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: Qualifying round leads to match play for those that qualify. Maximum of sixteen (16) qualifying spots (or closest USGA increment) available in each of the five flights.

WOMENS'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: Qualifying round leads to match play for those that qualify. USGA incremental system of 2, 4, 8, 16 match play seedings will be used to set pairings and avoid any byes.

CHALLENGE CUP (Non – Residents vs Residents): A fun event where the Residents of Pennsauken play a Match Play event against the Non – Residents of Pennsauken. A barbeque will follow the event.

JOHN COOPER MEMORIAL: Two-player aggregate shamble with gross and net division winners. Team receives 80% of handicap total for net division scoring. Both players will tee off, select the best drive of the two, and then play their own ball in from the selected tee shot. SIX TEE SHOT REQUIREMENT PER PLAYER!

JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: Individual stroke play over 18 holes in a net division format (full handicap).

INDIVIDUAL IN FLIGHT: Players compete in their own flight with their full handicap deducted from their 18-hole gross score.

JEFF SURRETTE PRESIDENT'S CUP:

Partner event over one weekend with four different 9-hole formats:

First Day @ Front Nine	=	better ball of partners with full handicap as it falls on the scorecard.
First Day @ Back Nine	=	two player scramble with a four (4) tee shot requirement per player.
Second Day @ Front Nine	=	alternate shot of partners with a four (4) tee shot requirement per player.
Second Day @ Back Nine	=	two player aggregate where each partner must hole out completely.

Partners receive 100% of handicap for better ball of partners, 25% of handicap total for two player scramble segment, 25% of handicap total for alternate shot of partners segment and 50% of handicap total for two player aggregate segment.

JUNIOR – SENIOR PARTNER SCRAMBLE: This is NOT a traditional Junior and Senior tournament. The two player teams, chosen by the pro shop staff, will be made by determining the median age for all the participants. Ex: if the median age is 55, all participants younger than 55 are considered juniors and all participants who are older than 55 will be considered seniors. The format is a two-player scramble with the team receiving 25% of their combined handicaps total.

SENIOR (age 60-69), SUPER SENIOR (age 70-79), and GOLDEN SENIOR (age 80 and older) CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: Individual stroke play over 36 holes with net division winner in each age group.

CHICAGO: Individual point system with players having their handicap deducted from the number 36 to determine their quota. Players then gain or lose points (using a pre-determined table) based on their hole by hole gross scores in attempting to match or surpass their quota.

MEMBER – GUEST: Two player scramble format with a six (6) tee shot requirement per player. with the member's handicap determining where the team starts in relation to par.

TOURNAMENT of CHAMPIONS: 18-hole individual stroke play with full handicap. All individual, gross division & net division winners are invited to participate in this season ending event with a cash prize awarded.

FLAG TOURNAMENT: Individual play receiving a percentage of your handicap plus 70. The awarding of prizes will be announced once finalized by the officers.

TURKEY SHOOT: The event format will be announced once finalized by the officers.
