

PENNSAUKEN COUNTRY CLUB SENIOR SCRAMBLE POLICIES & GUIDELINES FOR 2022

Listed below are the policies and guidelines for The Pennsauken Country Club Senior Scrambles. These policies and guidelines are set forth in looking to create equity and fairness amongst all participants. Please take a moment to carefully review these policies and guidelines as your participation is greatly anticipated:

- 1) Senior scrambles will be held on Monday and Thursday mornings throughout the entire year.
- 2) The Thursday senior scramble scheduled for the last Thursday of the month from April 1st thru October 31st will be superseded by a senior tournament scheduled for those dates.
- 3) Participants must be present on the back patio no later than 7:30 A.M. for an 8:00A.M. start (or 8:30 A.M. for a 9:00 A.M. start)
- 4) Participants must be at least 60 years of age.
- 5) Participants must register upon arrival with the senior committee member in charge.
- 6) The senior scramble entry fee for the 2022 season will be \$ 10.00 per player per event.
- 7) Entry fees must be remitted to the senior committee member in charge prior to beginning play.
- 8) All senior scrambles will begin play at 8:00 A.M. during April thru October and 9:00 A.M. during November thru March.
- 9) The pro shop staff will grant starting times to the senior scramble based on the previous two weeks average number of participants.
- 10) If a major holiday should fall on a Monday, the senior scramble will be moved to Tuesday. If a major holiday should fall on a Thursday, the senior scramble will be moved to a Wednesday.
- 11) Permission must be received from the pro shop staff if the senior scramble wishes to have fivesomes.
- 12) Non-members of Pennsauken Country Club are welcome to participate.
- 13) Females are welcome to participate.
- 14) All male participants will play from the gold tees.
- 15) All female participants will play from the red tees.

16) Teams will be drawn and organized at 7:30 AM for the 8:00 AM starts and at 8:30AM for the 9:00AM starts.

17) Club policy prohibits any practice on the golf course prior to beginning play.

18) Participants may rent a riding cart at their convenience and are asked to inform their respective teammates so as to avoid more than two riding carts going out in one group.

- 19) Participants renting golf carts are not permitted to give rides to players walking or to pull hand carts belonging to any players who are walking.
- 20) On occasion and based on the amount of play the facility is hosting, teams may be asked to have their two long ball players be the only ones to tee off on each hole to help keep up a good pace of play.

PENNSAUKEN COUNTRY CLUB SENIOR TOURNAMENT POLICIES AND GUIDELINES FOR 2022

Listed below are the policies and guidelines for The Pennsauken Country Club Senior Tournaments. These policies and guidelines are set forth in looking to create equity and fairness amongst all participants. Please take a moment to carefully review these policies and guidelines as your participation is greatly anticipated:

- Senior tournaments will be held on the last Thursday of the month for the time period of April 1st thru October 31st in a given season. The senior tournament will take the place of the senior scramble that would otherwise be scheduled for these dates.
- 2) The senior tournament schedule for the 2022 season will be as follows (formats may change):

April 28	Four Player A - B - C - D Mulligan Scramble
May 26	Four Player 3 Clubs and a Putter Scramble
June 23	Four Player Mike Weber Memorial A - B - C - D Scramble
July 28	Four Player Greg Hayes Emeritus All Par 3's Scramble
August 25	Four Player Joe Murtin, Sr. Memorial Three Tee Shots Per Player Scramble
September 29	Four Player Rick Taylor Memorial Split 9's Scramble
October 27	Four Player Dave Hartzell Memorial A - B - C - D Scramble & Year End Banquet

- 3) All senior tournaments will begin at 8:00 A.M.
- 4) Interested participants must be at least 60 years of age.
- 5) Non-members of Pennsauken Country Club are welcome to participate.
- 6) Females are welcome to participate.
- 7) There is a requirement to play in at least three (3) senior scrambles per month in order to be eligible for senior tournament scheduled on the last Thursday of each month (eff. Spring 2016).
- 8) Sign up sheets for the next scheduled senior tournament will be posted in the hallway on the bulletin board just outside the pro shop immediately following the completion of the current tournament.
- 9) The deadline for sign ups for each tournament will be the Thursday prior to the scheduled event at 2:00 P.M.

- 10) The entry fee for senior tournaments will be \$ 20.00 per event for the 2022 season.
- 11) Entry fees for a respective event are due and payable no later than the Thursday prior to the scheduled event during the regularly scheduled senior scramble and to the senior tournament committee member in charge.
- 12) Refunds will be granted in extreme medical or personal situations only!
- 13) A closest to the pin prize will be awarded on holes number 3, 7, 11 & 15 during all senior tournaments.
- 14) As per current policy of The Pennsauken Country Club Golf Association, prizes awarded during senior tournaments will be distributed to 25% of the field.
- 15) The pro shop staff will be responsible for all aspects of preparation for each senior tournament.
- 16) If the circumstance arises where a scheduled participant must withdraw from an event after the deadline, tournament pairings and starting times have been posted, a blind draw of the remaining participants will be used to fill this void.
- 17) If applicable, a format event sheet will be posted alongside the senior tournament sign up sheet in order to inform all prospective participants about the guidelines by which the event will be played.
- 18) In order to be eligible for the year end tournament (and accompanying banquet) held in October, a player must play in at least three (3) end of the month tournaments April thru September. THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS REQUIREMENT!
